

Clumber Park

Difficulty: Easy Length: 4.8miles / 7.7km

A circular trail around Clumber Park, our neighbouring estate managed by the National Trust in Nottinghamshire. The route will give you a chance to see many of the park's key features including Clumber Lake, Clumber Bridge, Clumber Chapel (often referred to as the Cathedral in Miniature) and a section of Limetree Avenue (the longest double-lined avenue of lime trees in Europe).

The route is fairly flat with no stiles or gates. There are a couple of short flights of seps and some of the paths can get a little muddy and uneven but generally the ground is very good, so the route would be suitable for a rugged pushchair.
